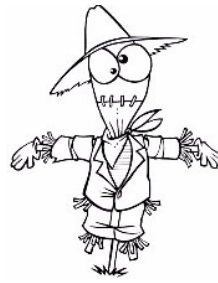


# If I Only Had A Brain

The song is sung in the 1939 film *The Wizard of Oz*



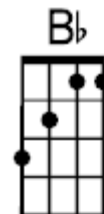
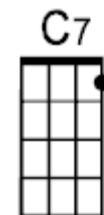
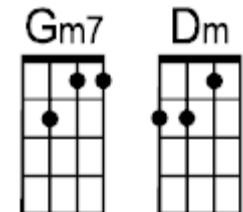
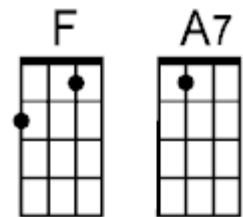
I could [F] wile away the hours
