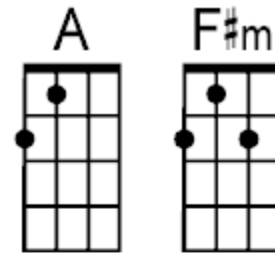
Latin Strum: D - D (arpegg) - U - U - D - U (arpeggiate the 2nd down stroke)

[D] But will you [E7] love me to-[A]morrow?

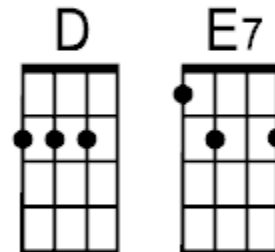


[A] Is this a [F#m] lasting [D] treasure [E7]

[D] Will you still [E7] love me to-[A]morrow?

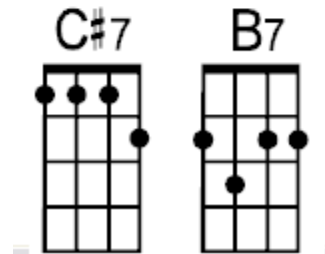


To-[D]night with words un-[A]spoken
