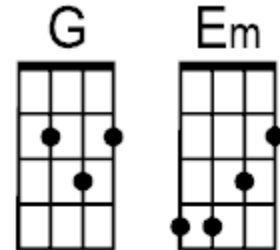
Latin Strum: D - D (arpegg) - U - U - D - U (arpeggiate the 2nd downstroke)

[C] But will you [D] love me to-[G]morrow?

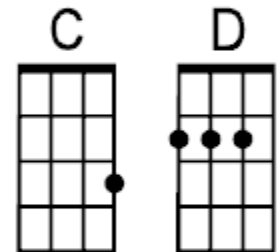


[G] Is this a [Em] lasting [C] treasure [D]

[C] Will you still [D] love me to-[G]morrow?

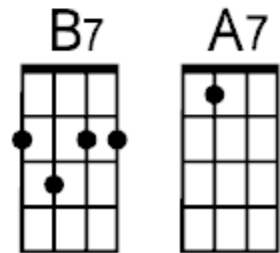


To-[C]night with words un-[G]spoken
