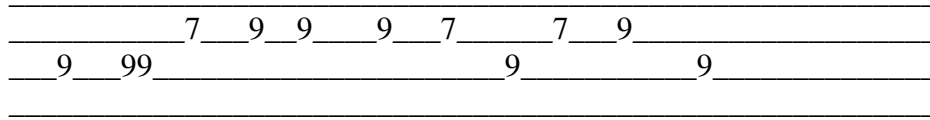


# I WISH I KNEW YOU IN KINDERGARTEN
